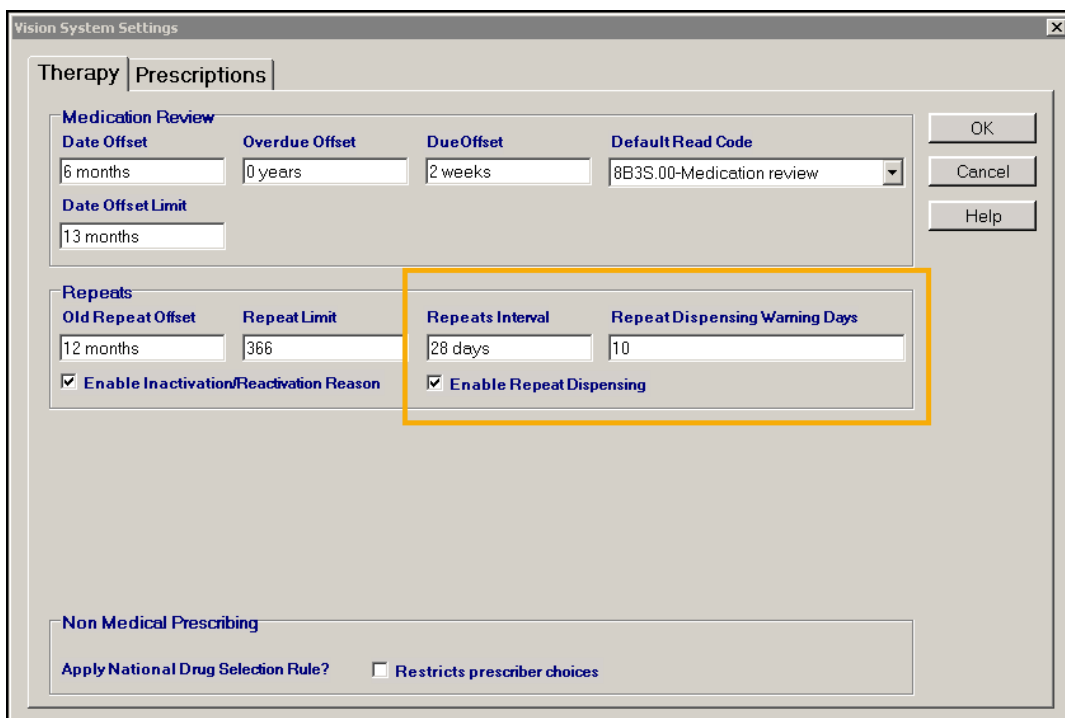

Vision 3 release **DLM 840** contains the following new features and improvements:

Management Tools

- **Therapy Configuration** - The following options are now disabled in **Consultation - Options - Setup - Therapy** and are now accessed from **Management Tools - Control Panel - File Maintenance - Settings - Therapy**:
 - **Repeats Interval** - The setting for your default practice wide repeat interval.
 - **Repeat Dispensing** - The settings for Repeat Dispensing in your practice:

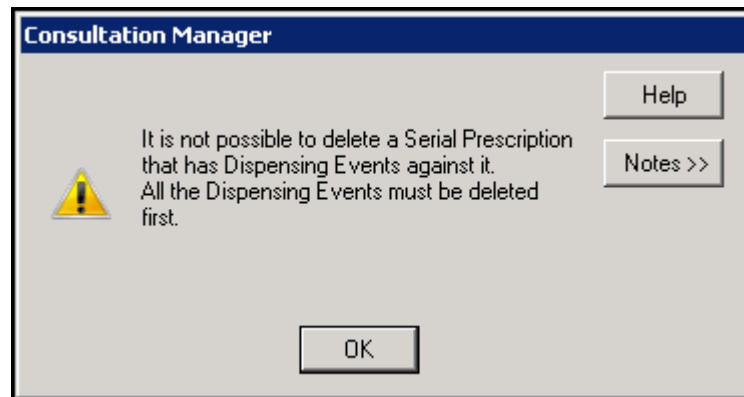

- **Deleting CMS (Serial Prescribing) Prescriptions** - If you try and delete a CMS (Serial Prescribing) prescription with dispensing events against it, the 'It is not possible to delete a Serial Prescription that has Dispensing Events against it. All the Dispensing Events must be deleted first' warning displays:



If you do need to delete a CMS (Serial Prescribing) master, you must delete any dispensing events first, then you can delete the CMS (Serial Prescribing) master.

- **Preferred Pharmacy** - The issue with the **Preferred Pharmacy** not printing on a prescription if the name is over 13 characters long without a space, has been addressed.
