

- Age-related Prescribing Precautions** - When prescribing for patients under one month old, age-related prescribing precautions do not display. - **Acute issue**, to create a repeat master retaining the same details as the repeat issue you are copying:




## England and Wales

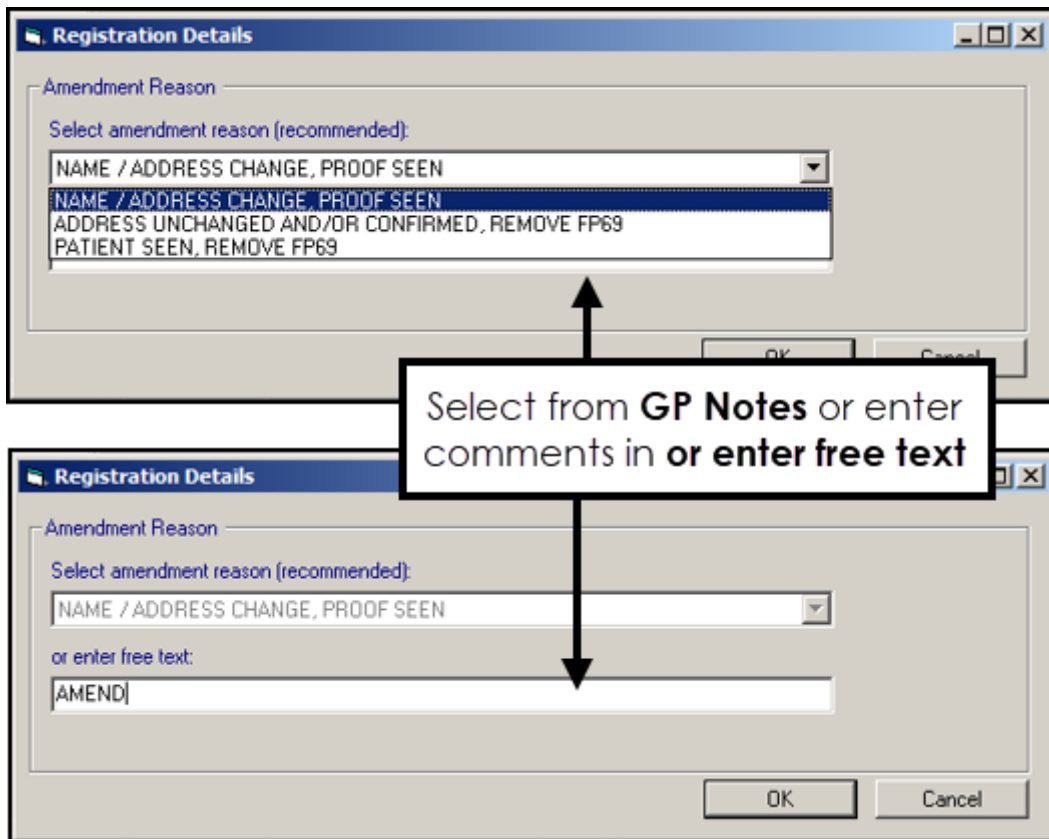
- **GP Notes** - When you register a new patient, the **GP Notes** section now has a list to select from, or you can enter free text:

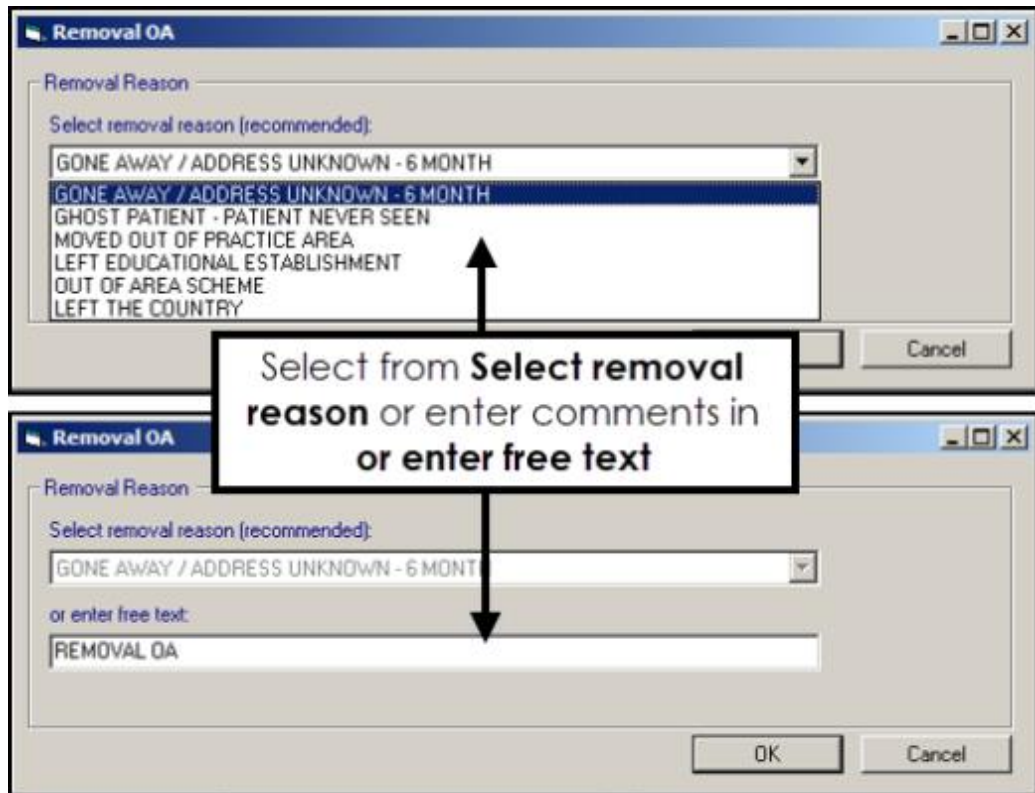

- **Deductions** - When you are processing a deduction from **Registration Links**, you can select from the available list, or enter comments in **or enter free text**:



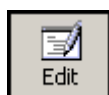
## Control Panel

- **Residential Institutes (RI)** - The **Identifier Value** for all RIs must now be updated to:
  - **V0** for Nursing/Residential Care Homes.
  - **Y0** for Students.

This change must be done manually at your earliest convenience.

To make the change:

1. From **Control Panel**, select **File Maintenance - Organisation** and highlight one of your RIs.



2. Select **Edit**.
3. Select the **Identifiers** tab.
4. Update the **Identifier Value** to either **V0** or **Y0** depending on the RI type.
5. Select **OK** to save.

## England Only

- **Clinical Practice Research Datalink (CPRD)** - Where a patient has chosen to not share their confidential information for research and planning purposes via the **National Data Opt-out Service**, their data is no longer included in a **CPRD** data collection.


- **Chronic Medication Service (CMS) Therapy Reorder form** - When you issue a **CMS** prescription, the **Reorder** form now prints by default.

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- **Instalment Prescribing** - You can now print a **Medication Schedule** for a patient on an instalment plan.
  1. From **Consultation Manager**, with the patient selected, press **F9** on your keyboard and **Prescription Manager** displays:
