




## **DLM 420 - Therapy - Non-Standard Preparations**

From DLM 420, you are no longer able to enter free text in the preparation box for therapy items. Instead you must use the dm+d preparation(s) provided with the selected drug item. If the default preparation is not suitable, you can look for an alternative in the Pack Details button, adjust your quantity information to suit or select another item from the drug list. (This functionality has already been in place for English practices using Electronic Prescribing for some time).

**Reminder** - You can use the Additional Information box on the Therapy Add form to enter any additional free text for the dispenser.

When adding a new drug item, if you enter free text in the preparation box, you will not be able to save the therapy form and the following advice is displayed:



## **Existing Therapy Items with Non-standard Preparations**

Existing therapy items with non-standard preparations are displayed on all Repeat therapy screens (including the CMS screen for Scottish practices) with the preparation highlighted in red text.
