



QOF v 16 Business Rules

Update - Scottish Practices Only

There has been a problem with the PP01 numerator lines for Scottish practices since the audits for the version 16 business rules have been installed. The associated Data Quality audits imported a search for the CVD risk assessments that overwrote the Scottish search with one for England. This means that the ASSIGN scores are not currently showing as counting towards the PP01 denominator.

A fix has been written and is currently being tested. As soon as this is available, we will be applying an upgrade to all Scottish sites. We expect this to be installed very quickly but will also be posting the fix on the website should you wish to apply this earlier. In the meantime please continue to use the ASSIGN score as normal as they will be picked up in the final report.

Changes in v16 Business Rules

This User Guide explains the changes that will be met for version 16 of the business rules for those who are currently on version 15.

Note that this update will be released under a new Supplementary Install Stream (SIS), in this case SIS 10000, and is independent of DLM releases.

Note – A small error has been found with one line in the Data Quality audits V16006:

Obesity QOF Indicators - Total Practice Population.

This line has not been set to do a daily generate and so it is not being refreshed each day. The line is however, being refreshed at each monthly generate. This means that the percentages for each of the child lines in Obesity will be blank and the figure for the Total Practice Population will be as of the end of the previous month. The reporting audits which send the message to QMAS are **completely unaffected** by this and therefore, calculations of payments will **not** be affected.


