Audit for HPA MMR Catch Up Campaign Update for 2011-2012 (Version 5, 13/02/2012)

The HPA MMR Catch Up Campaign audit had been updated for 2011-2012 and will show all patients eligible for catch up MMR vaccination.

- The birth date ranges have been moved on a year.
- The specification from the DH this year differs from last year in that only the compound (triple valent) MMR vaccination is reported; separate vaccinations for measles, mumps and rubella will not be counted as a valid MMR vaccination.
- In addition, MMR stage 1 must be on or after 12 months and the booster must be on or after age 18 months and at least 3 months after the MMR Stage 1.
- In **England** this data will be used to populate a message that is sent to DH ImmForm website in early September. Note that the red lines are not reported and are grouped at the bottom of the audit.

Audit for HPA Pneumococcal Reporting and Call & Recall Update, v3, 12/01/12

Reporting audits

 HPA Pneumococcal reporting will show ALL vaccinations given to eligible patients by the end of March 2012. For English practices, at the beginning of April 2012, data up to 31st March 2012 will be automatically written to a message from the reporting lines and transmitted to the DH ImmForm website.

For LAN practices to successfully submit the SIS10100 PPV report, you must install the HPA Influenza Extract update from the INPS web site http://www.inps4.co.uk/my_vision/vua/cfh.

Call and recall audits

HPA Pneumococcal Call & Recall audit is valid for ALL countries to ensure that
patients eligible for Pneumococcal vaccination have been offered. The dates of
birth have been moved on a year and the reporting time frame has moved
from 2010-11 to 2011-12.

English Practices

The program to generate the messages to the ImmForm website is relatively new to Vision. It has been installed for ALL the managed service sites or is included in DLM 390.
