

No tick default in Suspend National Services on PDS update

When presented with a PDS update screen, you have the choice to suspend or maintain National Services when Defer Vision Update is selected.

On the PDS Updates Available screen, the Suspend National Services will now have no tick by default. If you then choose to Defer Vision Update, neither the Spine nor Vision will be updated with any demographic data. But, you will be able to access any National Services for this patient.



If you tick to select Suspend National Services and then select Defer Vision Update, neither the Spine nor Vision will be updated with any demographic data.


The patient will be unlinked with the Spine and you will not be able to access any of the National Services for this patient.

Urgency picklist for ICATS referrals in Northern Ireland

Throughout Northern Ireland there is a new system for processing referrals called ICATS (Integrated Care and Treatment Service) which is being established to help reduce the length of time patients are waiting to receive treatment.

All Practices have been provided with the referral template ICATS.DOC which has been placed automatically in P:\wordproc\template after a DLM installation.

On ICATS referrals, practices are asked to grade the referrals as follows, and the change has been made to the picklist under Urgency in Referrals-Add:



Using the ICATS referral template in Referral Add

In order to use the ICATS template, you need to have Word installed on your Vision workstation.

In Referral Add, when clicking on the Letter button Add, highlight ICATS.doc from the offered files on Select Referral Template to Open and click on Open. This will open the ICATS Referral Letter and display the merged information.

The report can now be edited as required. If the letter is unprotected (Tools - Unprotect Document), you can edit the document wherever you want. Some fields where there is a shaded area may require an entry, including:


- · Preferred contact details
- GP Cipher
- (Patient) Known As
- History of presenting complaint
- · Test results included / awaited
- Social History

To delete unwanted text, right click on the line, select Delete Cells and then Delete entire row. This then does not leave a blank line. To delete several rows, first highlight the rows, right click and select Delete Rows.

Print the letter using the Print button <a> on the top tool bar and Close.

When the letter is closed, a prompt will appear asking if you want to save changes for this letter (remember that this is just for this patient's ICAT - it does not affect the template). Click on Yes to save the changes made.

red tick will now appear on the Letter button showing a letter has been created. To save the record click on the OK button.



Editing an ICATS Referral Letter

If you want to return to a referral letter to change something:

- 1. From Consultation Manager, select the correct patient and locate the original letter in the Journal.
- 2. Right mouse click and select Edit from the menu offered. Clinical Correspondence Update will now appear at the bottom of the screen.
- 4. Then print the new version of the letter, if required.
- 5. Close the report and click on Yes to the Do you want to save changes prompt.

IM&T DES England version 2.2 amendments

Version 2.2 of IM&T DES for England has brought some changes. The audits are now version 13, 23/11/2007.
